Dear Sponsor:

Your candidate has been accepted for the Chrysalis scheduled for _____.
You should begin NOW to prepare for his/her successful participation in these three days.

As Sponsor you need to:

1. Prayerfully consider your role and responsibilities to your candidate.
2. Make yourself available to help meet the needs of your candidate.
3. Properly prepare your candidate for the flight.
4. Find friends and family to support your candidate with "Agape" letters.
5. Encourage and assist your candidate to find a sharing group after the flight.
6. Bring your candidate to Hoots.
7. Continue to work with your candidate as a fellow Christian.

Your specific responsibilities for the flight are:

1. Arrange for your candidate's transportation to the FFA Retreat Center in North Myrtle Beach. Arrive no later than 8AM on Saturday to check in.
2. Participate in the Sponsor's Hour at 8:30 AM on the arrival date. **INVITE PARENTS** to attend Sponsor's Hour. This is a brief service of meditation and prayer where you will also participate In Holy Communion on behalf of your candidate.
3. Attend Candlelight Service at 8PM on Sunday at the FFA Retreat Center.
INVITE PARENTS.
4. Attend the closing service on Monday at 5:30 PM **INVITE PARENTS.**
5. Arrange for the candidate's transportation home following the closing. (if parents are not taking candidate home).

AGAPE LETTERS:

One of the first things you should do is get THE Agape letters from family and special friends of the candidate. These letters are a vitally important demonstration of God's grace and love. please approach this responsibility PRAYERFULLY AND SOON. Do not send your candidates gifts during the weekend, only letters and notes.

Enclosed you will find a request letter for your candidate. You may choose to send the letter to obtain the Agape letters directly from friends and family. You are responsible to gather the letters yourself. Ten or twelve letters is best. It's quality...not quantity and bring them to the FFA Camp no later than 8PM Sunday evening.

Please encourage your candidate to leave their phone and/or tablet at home!

Things to Do for Sponsorship

- 1) Pray about who you intend to sponsor. Remember they must be at least a **sophomore** in high school.
- 2) Give the parent the "**Parent Letter**" directly (don't let the caterpillar see it).
- 3) Give the caterpillar the "Packing List" and make sure they understand; a) they CANNOT have their phone out during the weekend, and b) what reunion groups are AFTER Chrysalis and they are welcome to attend.
- 4) Make sure the application is filled out completely and if the caterpillar's parents are divorced- that both parents know they are attending and we have both parents' information.
- 5) We need to know on the application if the caterpillar has any allergies, what/when they take their meds (because they won't know what time it is) and if they have a special diet due to allergies or otherwise.
- 6) The times for the weekend are on the Sponsor Guide and Parent Letter.
- 7) Remember how special your Agape Letters were to you... make them a priority!
- 8) If you are serving on the team while you are a sponsor, make sure you have secured transportation for your caterpillar for Saturday morning at **8:00 AM SHARP**.
- 9) It's a HUGE deal if a sponsor brings a caterpillar late because it pushes the entire morning behind. Make sure to have them there at **8 AM SHARP**.
- 10) With their application, if they can go ahead and pay the \$100, that makes the Saturday morning registration easier. If not, just send the \$25. Never turn anyone away though! If you have someone that wants to go- talk to a Chrysalis Board member and we will work it out.
- 11) There will be team members lined up when your caterpillars arrive. The team members will take their bags- make sure the caterpillar immediately goes inside and gets registered first.
- 12) Sponsor's Hour is very important because that's another time the caterpillar's cross gets prayed over. The sponsor ALWAYS needs to attend unless they are on the Team. If they are a team member, they need to pre-arrange to have a friend/family member pray over that caterpillar's cross. The sponsor should also invite the Parents to attend Sponsor's Hour to learn more about Chrysalis and what their child will be experiencing.

If you would like to write to the caterpillar listed above, I can assure you that your efforts will help make their weekend more meaningful! Please write your letter, place it in a sealed envelope with the caterpillar's **FIRST AND LAST NAME** on the outside and then give it to me or bring it to the events during the weekend. The deadline to provide letters will be on Sunday evening at 8pm.

If you have an issue bringing the letter or note, please contact me. You may also email the letter to me and I will print and give to the candidate. If you need anything else please feel free to contact the Registrar below.
